Energy use in manufacturing 2023

The aim of the inquiry on energy use in manufacturing is to find out the volume of electricity, heat and fuels used in your enterprise's establishment. In this inquiry, the volume of electricity refers to total consumption of electricity used in the establishment and the amount of electricity purchased for own use or sold. The form also has questions about small-scale production of renewable energy. If you have own small-scale production of electricity it is not, however, subtracted from the total consumption of electricity used at the establishment. The volume of heat refers to the amount of heat purchased or sold. The volume of fuels refers to the amount of total consumption that is reported separately for each fuel. The data can also be reported according to energy content.

The inquiry covers mining and quarrying and enterprises operating in the manufacturing industries. The data are collected partly from a sample and by using other sources of data. Therefore, not all establishments of multi-establishment enterprises are necessarily included in the inquiry.

The data are used in the compilation of statistics on energy use in manufacturing. The data are also utilised in the greenhouse gas inventory and in international reporting.

Statistics Finland's Suomi.fi mandate is "**Responding to data collections from enterprises and organisations**" and the mandate definer is **teen**. An establishment definer can be attached to the mandate if necessary. The definer can be found in the top right corner of this letter. By means of the definer the enterprise can define the mandate to relate only to a certain establishment.) Further information on the obligation to provide data and treatment of the data

Confidentiality, data protection and publicity

Statistics Finland uses the data for the compilation of statistics. Unit level data collected for statistical purposes must be kept confidential by virtue of Section 24, Paragraph 1, Sub-paragraph 16 of the Act on the Openness of Government Activities (621/1999). According to Section 13 of the Statistics Act (280/2004), Statistics Finland may also release data for scientific studies and statistical surveys without data enabling direct identification.

The data are protected against unauthorised access in accordance with the data protection rules adopted by Statistics Finland. The Statistics Act prohibits the use of data collected for statistical purposes in an investigation, surveillance, legal proceedings, administrative decision-making, or other similar handling of a matter concerning the enterprise. Unit-level data on enterprises may only be handled at Statistics Finland by persons whose tasks require the use of such data. Obligation to provide data

The obligation to provide data is based on Sections 14 and 15 of the Finnish Statistics Act (280/2004). Notwithstanding the provisions on data secrecy, entrepreneurs are obliged to provide Statistics Finland with such data that are necessary for the compilation of statistics. By virtue of Section 21 of the Statistics Act, Statistics Finland is entitled to receive these data free of charge.

By virtue of Section 8 of the Statistics Act, data providers have the right to seek exemption from the obligation to provide data wholly or partially if the provision of data causes the respondent unreasonable inconvenience and the exemption will not essentially hamper the production of statistics or weaken the reliability and usability of statistics. Unreasonable inconvenience refers to putting the respondent in an unequal position with regard to other data providers. Duration of storage

Digital statistical data formed from the supplied data are permanently stored at Statistics Finland in accordance with the National Archives of Finland's confirmed storage period decision (KA/19843/07.01.01.03.01/2017).

The compilation of statistics on energy use in manufacturing is based on the EU Regulation on energy statistics (Regulation No 1099/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council on energy statistics).
